3D Printing: Now at the Library!

Find or Design a 3D Model and print it at the library!

How does it work? 3D printing takes molten material and passes it through a super-heated nozzle via a robotic arm. The machine will form the material (we use plastic) layer by layer into the desired object. The plastic cools off within a few seconds, so the finished object can be used right away.

3D PRINTING COSTS

PLA/HIPS: \$3.00 up to one ounce
\$2.00 for each additional ounce

ABS: \$5.00 up to one ounce
\$3.00 for each additional ounce

Completed 3D prints must be paid for at time of pick-up.
No refunds will be given for completed 3D prints.
Library staff will only be able to provide an estimated cost before printing. Final charges will be based on completed 3D print weight.

If estimated project cost is \$15.00 or more, payment of 50% of total estimated print cost is due at time of request.

How to Get a Library Card

Getting a library card is easy. If you are a resident of Richland County, you only need to come into the library with a photo ID that shows your current address. If your ID does not have your current address, you will need to bring in a proof of address—this could include any piece of non-junk mail, a utility bill, etc. Children under 16 will need to come in with a Parent or Guardian. There is no charge for a resident library card.

If you are not a resident of Richland County, you can still get a card. Minnesota residents who have a LARL library card are able to receive a card at no charge via our reciprocal agreement. All other non-residents may pay a \$10 fee to get a card good for up to 3 years.

Borrow an iPad

Members of the library are able to borrow an iPad for two weeks. In order to borrow an iPad, you must be over 18 and have had a card in good standing for at least 3 months. iPads are loaded with a variety of apps. All iPads are equipped so that members may download library eBooks or eAudiobooks from Library2Go or digital magazines from Zinio.
